The purpose of this proposed increase is to assist the club in handling the cost of meeting room space that is large enough to handle the club. Please attend the August meeting as more discussion will take place and any questions you may have will be addressed.

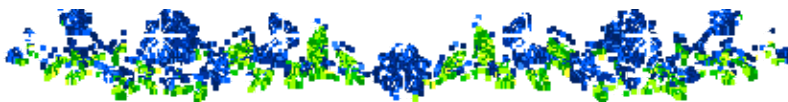

Running Hot Time of the Year

The hottest time of the year is here, but that doesn't mean your car engine will only run hot now. Hot running engines are a problem that corvettes have been plagued with for several generations. In most cases the problem can be attributed to over rated radiator capacity or a worn out radiator. The way to correct this problem is to replace the stock GM radiator with an after market one that is made for that generation and the engine size. There are many good ones to choose from and many companies that sell those (Mid America Motorworks, Ecklers, Corvette Central, West Coast Corvette, et al not to mention the local auto store that has a wide selection. The price varies to match the quality and materials used in the radiator (aluminum versus brass/copper). Now what do you do with the radiator? Replace it yourself or have a mechanic do the work. That one depends on your ability and having the correct shop manual to make the decision. So do your homework and good luck with your new radiator to keep your "hot" engine cool.


